General Spring Break Tips

1. Be prepared for any type of weather

a. **BRING LAYERS!**

a. **DO NOT TRAVERSE ACROSS TERRAIN. SKIING & RIDING DOWNHILL IS MORE FUN!**

4. **DROP A PIN - KNOW YOUR LOCATION!**

5. **CELL SERVICE ISN'T THE BEST**

a. **HAVE A DESIGNATED TIME & LOCATION IN CASE YOU GET SEPARATED**



Spring Break Tips from Base Operations

- **Carpool & ride with your friends or family to save gas.**
- **Have enough gas to get to and from the ski area.**
- **Watch for pedestrians in parking lots.**
- **Please follow guidance of parking attendants.**
- **Be patient during busy times as parking fills quickly.**
- **Ask your shuttle bus driver for your parking lot location as well as any questions you may have. They can help direct you.**
- **Drop-Offs:** drivers please remain in the vehicle at all times and be prepared when dropping off your party.
- **Don't Litter:** Keep the parking lot clean by properly disposing of trash or recyclables. Avoid leaving behind any litter.
- **Back out of your parking spot slowly.**
- **Maximize space by not taking up more than necessary.**
- **Keep keys safe or have a spare.**
- **Turn off all electronics in the vehicle once parked.**

Spring Break Tips

Ticket Office

- **SAVE TIME & BUY ONLINE!** Tickets are reloadable if purchased online at shop.WolfCreekSki.com. Tickets purchased in-person at the Ticket Office are NOT reloadable.
- **Reloadable tickets, once printed, allow direct lift access** by purchasing lift access online that loads to your printed ticket.
- **Online Lift Tickets can be printed at Ticket Kiosks**, located outside on the deck next to Treasure Sports.
- **Military Tickets** cannot be printed at the Pickup Boxes; please **go to the Ticket Office**.
- A **Satellite Ticket Office** Window will be open the morning of **Sunday, March 15th thru Tuesday, March 17th**. Located below Prospector Grill, facing the 4x4 Parking Lot.
- **Pre-purchased lessons go directly to designated lesson area** (see Ski School Tips).
- Pre-purchased tickets picked up at the Ticket Office require the **ID of the purchaser and the credit card** used to purchase the tickets.
- **Guests paying with a credit card (& seniors) will be asked for a photo I.D.** to verify their card/age.
- **Have your form of payment ready.**

Spring Break Tips

Ticket Pickup Boxes

- Lift tickets purchased online at shop.WolfCreekSki.com can be printed at the Ticket Kiosks.
- To print tickets at the Kiosks, you will need your **Wolf Creek Order Confirmation Email** that displays the order barcode.
- Screenshot or download your order confirmation where the **barcode is scannable** to save you time at the Kiosks.
- The Order Barcode is scanned by the Kiosk, and the **tickets print and are released into the hopper**.
- Once the ticket is printed, it will allow direct lift access by purchasing lift access online that loads to your printed ticket.
- **Military & Group Lesson Tickets can not be printed at the Kiosks.** Military Tickets can be printed at the Ticket Office. Group Lessons will be available to the students in the respective lesson location (see Ski School Tips).
- Lift tickets are RFID, which makes your ticket scannable thru your jacket or pants. **Lift tickets will go in a LEFT side chest or sleeve pocket, by themselves.** Don't put tickets in gloves.

Spring Break Tips from Lift Department

- If you are unfamiliar with how to use a lift, please ask the lift attendant.
- Keep your ticket in a left side pocket, by itself.
- Wait for enough room before approaching the gate.
- If you have a backpack, remove it and place it in front of you to prevent it from becoming entangled in the chair during unload.
- If you don't make it into the chair, do not hang onto the chair. If your partner does not make it into the chair, do not hang onto your partner.
- Avoid swinging or bouncing the chair. Lower the restraint device.
- No horseplay while riding.
- Check for loose clothing and equipment before unloading.
- Clear the unload area after getting off the chair.
- If you fall, try to move quickly out of way so the next chair has a clear path.

Spring Break Tips from Rental Shop

- Online reservations **CANNOT** be picked up the afternoon prior.
- No helmet, glove, jacket, goggle or clothing rentals is available on the mountain.
 - These items are available for purchase in Treasure Sports (next door).
- Before 8 a.m. is great! Rental Shops open at 7:00 a.m.
- Snowboard Rental is at Stokin' Rentals.
- Understand your skier type.
- We do not rent blades.
- Wolf Creek Ski & Snowboard Rental is accepting reservations for the upcoming Spring Break Holiday via, shop.wolfcreekski.com. Limited time slots available. Due to the growing number of reservations, renting equipment from 3:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. the afternoon prior to your start date will not be available March 15th, 16th, 17th or 18th. Wolf Creek Rental Shops will continue to always welcome walk-in rentals starting at 7:00 a.m. on your first day of skiing.

Spring Break Tips from Treasure Sports

- **Treasure Sports has helmets, gloves, jackets, goggles and clothing for purchase!! We do not have any of those items for rent.**
- **Shop Early!!** Don't wait until the end of the day as the store will be busy and shopping will not be as easy and accessible. The store is open from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- **Be prepared to purchase a locker to hold your items.** Lockers are \$0.75, cash can be exchanged for quarters.
- **Let 1 person bring all items to the counter for purchase.** The shop runs more smoothly and more quickly when there are fewer people in the store.
